CALLING POST

We have received some concerns regarding the Calling Post system. Calling Post may appear on the caller ID as "Oklahoma" or "(405) 308 4474" instead of "Calling Post". The automated computer responds to human voice, you must speak to trigger the message. If a person does not speak, the auto dialer will disconnect and try again later. Every subsequent call the auto dialer will take a few seconds longer before the message will play. There may be a significant lag between when you speak and when the computer reacts.

FAMILY PROMISE UPDATE:

Family Promise of Aiken County is continuing to make progress in bringing this ministry to Aiken. The Host Recruitment Team received its first invitation to present to a local congregation. The team, including Pastor Irene, presented to First Baptist Church at their Wednesday evening program on August 28th. The next community meeting will be held on September 3rd. Please plan to attend future meetings to learn more about Family Promise as a well-established ministry for families experiencing homelessness.

REGIONAL CHURCH NEWS

On August 10th, Jim and Judee Mitchel and Ed and Pastor Irene Albritton attended a South Carolina Regional Church Board meeting at Galilee Christian Church, Holly Hill SC. The meeting was open to all persons interested in the future direction of the Regional Church, and was well attended. The Board voted to accept the Push-to-Purpose declaration and identity statement and to advertise for a new Regional Minister. Interim Regional Minister Juan Rodriquez will end his second six-month term on November 30th. The job description has been posted nation-wide and the search team plans to begin interviewing Candidates in October. The Board also approved the appointment of an eight-member Push-to-Purpose Transition team to work with both the Search team and the new Regional Minister to continue the work that has been started under Pastor Juan's leadership. Pastor Irene was appointed to this team and attended its first meeting on Monday, August 26th at the Regional office in Charleston. More information will be shared at the Regional Church Conference Oct 4-5th in Holly Hill. Please plan to attend.
