MESSAGE FROM PASTOR IRENE

Like you, I have never experienced so much change in the world as I knew it as I have experienced since our last Newsletter went out just a short, yet very long, month ago. We are all learning new ways of doing things, and I pray that each of you are staying safe and taking care of yourself. If you need assistance with getting supplies or food, please let me or one of the Elder's know. Also, please stay in touch with each other and with me, and join in the worship services as often as you can. Sunday School and Worship are both available via telephone conference call numbers (see below) and worship is also available in video form - either as a live feed or as a recorded video for later viewing. All instructions are included in this newsletter. If you have trouble connecting, please let me know. And remember, "God is our refuge and our strength, a very present help in trouble." (Psalm 46:1).

Directions for accessing worship opportunities:

- <u>For people with internet connection</u> on their computer / tablet or phone, there are two different options: watching it 'live' as it happens or watching it later as a recorded video:
 - o Live streaming of the 11am worship service:
 - If you use Facebook, please "like" our church facebook page and you will be notified when the live feed is about to begin.
 - If you do not use Facebook, please follow these step by step instructions:
 - Open your internet browser
 - Type in the following address in the search bar: https://www.facebook.com/FirstChristianChurchAiken/
 - When that page comes up, click the "x" at the box that pops up asking you to log in or create an account. NO account or signin is necessary to access the church page.
 - Once you have closed the sign-in box, it will disappear and the regular Facebook page will be visible. The live video will show and at the appropriate time, click the arrow to begin watching/listening.
 - o Later viewing of the worship service video
 - If you are unable to watch at 11, you can watch it later by following the same instructions under "ii" above, and click on 'videos'.
 - Scott will also add a link to the recorded video in the usual "Recent Sermon" section of the church website (<u>www.firstchristian-aiken.org</u>) and you can click it to watch at your convenience.
- For people without internet the worship service will be repeated at 12:15 via Conference Call. For those of you using the conference call approach for Sunday School, the only difference is the telephone number.
 - o To access the conference call, dial 1-623-600-3766 at 12:15 Sunday. When prompted, enter the code 935647 to be joined with the conference call. (this should be a free call on most cell-phone plans if the phone call is a long distance call for you, please let me know)
 - Please do not call in early for this call I will begin the call promptly at 12:15 and will wait to begin the service until everyone has had a time to check in.



Communion Kit Refills

We have gotten a good response from many of you about the Communion Kits. As you know, they only came filled with two week's worth. However now that the President has extended the social distancing restrictions to the end of April, we will be making up refill packets to include communion supplies for four weeks. If you do not want to receive a communion packet refill, please let me know by email (pastorirenefcca@gmail.com) or by telephone (803-394-6282) by this Friday, April 3rd.

If you DO want refills, you have two options:

- 1. Pick-up Service: Communion refill kits will be available this Sunday afternoon, April 5th, between 1pm 3pm. I will be in the parking lot at the church for your convenience in driving by and picking up your packet. You will not need to get out of your vehicle. It will be good to see you at a safe distance and also get your worship supplies to you.
- 2. Delivery Service: If you cannot make it to the church during that time, please let me know by Friday, April 3rd, and we can arrange porch delivery like we did the first time.

Normally after the Easter Worship Service, we decorate our outside cross with fresh flowers, to celebrate Christ's resurrection. This year we are limiting contact, so a flower display will be added to the cross for us.

DURING THIS TIME

We are making some changes to how things are done during this time. Prayer requests may be emailed to the church at any time. Those received by Monday will be added to the Sunday bulletin, the rest will be added the following week, but may be mentioned during the service or via emailed bulletins. The extended delay is for those who receive the bulletin via mail.

Offerings may be sent directly to Caroline our financial secretary. That will save her a trip to the church office. Her address is in the directory.

Many services and some meetings will be available for those with computer access. We have a new facebook page where services are live streamed. Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter will all be live streamed at the times they were originally planned. The Carry In is canceled.

Those without computer access can receive Communion by phone using the conference call system. See the article above.

The Sunday Service conference call takes place at 12:15, the facebook worship services are at the regularly scheduled times.

Sunday School is being offered via conference call. The number may change, contact the church office via email if you would like to be added.

OLD FASHIONED SUNDAY SCHOOL VIA MODERN TECHNOLOGY: H. Bryan Riley, Ph.D.

Given Plato stated, "Necessity Is Literally the Mother of Invention" and Alexander Graham Bell is credited with inventing the first practical telephone in 1876, we blended these two concepts on Sunday, March 22nd. The result was a successful and virtual implementation of our First Christian Church Sunday School class. Specifically, we were able to provide a toll-free number and an access code that allowed multiple participants to join a moderated conference call. By 9:40 A.M. the conference call was underway, and it allowed for verbal interactions and exchanges in a seamless manner. As others was successful to join the conference call and we followed the normal format of an opening prayer, praise reports, prayer requests and then discussion of the lesson per the guidebook.

Turns out the Sunday School lesson was entitled "God Shepherds Us" and was based on Psalm 23 scriptures. Given what is normal for our class, we had a wonderful Sunday School discussion where several persons were sitting apart in the fellowship hall and others voiced their interpretation and personalization of Psalm 23 over telephone speaker. Collectively as a church family we did not allow any hinderances to the reading, studying, and sharing the bread of life (i.e., Gods Word) Thus, as Matthew 4:4 states, "But he answered, "It is written, "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God".

For me personally, this Sunday School lesson is an amazing testimony as to how God provided us with exactly what we need and when we need it. Psalm 23 is very appropriate to provide comfort and affirmation that God is our protector and provider even in these turbulent times of COVID19. The conference call which allowed for our Sunday morning discussions and sharing can only be characterized as a blessing. For that we are thankful and give thanks to Our Lord and Savior.
