Pastor's Note

Psalm 32:1 says "happy are those whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered." Lent, while somber and reflective, actually invites all of us into that state of happiness that forgiveness brings. Lent invites us into the awareness and confession of sins so that we can experience the incredible gift of the joy and energy that follows true forgiveness. I pray each of you are having a meaningful season of Lent as we walk closer to the cross and then to the joy of Easter.

Lenten worship sermon series: Encounters with Jesus

During the four Sundays in March, we will be using the gospel reading in John to guide us in a series of exploring encounters people had with the living Christ. The readings are longer than normal, so the actual reading during worship will focus on a particular part of the story. To help you prepare for the Bible study and also as part of your Lenten devotions, here are the full readings and the person we will be studying who encountered Jesus in person.

March 5 - Nicodemus John 3: 1-17

March 12 - Samaritan Woman John 4: 5-42

March 19 – Blind Man John 9:1-41 March 26 – Lazarus John 11:1-45
